PASTOR'S CORNER

Christ is risen! Alleluia! Our sins are washed away!

Our Lord Jesus Christ paid the ultimate prize for our sins by shedding His Blood on the Cross. But on the third day God raised Him from the dead to bring sinners hope of salvation from sin. In today's second reading, St. John reminds us that Jesus remains our advocate when we are confronted with the harsh reality of sin.

Peace be with you!

Jesus' favorite word after His resurrection is "peace." It is almost always the first word on His lips when He appears to His apostles, as we can see in today's gospel. Every time we celebrate Mass, we hear these same words, spoken to us in the here-and-now of our lives, right before we receive the living, resurrected Body, and Blood of our Lord in Holy Communion: "Lord Jesus Christ," the priest says, "You said to Your apostles: I leave you peace, My peace I give you." He didn't give this peace before His resurrection, but afterwards, and He gives it because we need it.

All Fear is Gone

Christ's peace is the antidote to most endemic diseases of modern, secular society: anger, fear, stress, depression, anxiety, violence, war, the list goes on and on. We have all been affected by those diseases. As our friendship with the resurrected Lord grows deeper, we are gradually healed of those diseases, because He brings us His three-fold peace: peace of mind, heart and soul!
