The True Vine

In today's gospel, Jesus uses the image of the vine and its branches to remind us that alone and unaided, we are as spiritually worthless as the cutoff branch of a vine, which is the most worthless of all wood! Life that is not rooted in God is empty and useless. "It is tempting to think", writes Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, "that today's advanced technology can answer all our needs and save us from all the perils and dangers that beset us. But it is not so. At every moment of our lives, we depend entirely on God, in whom we live and move and have our being. Only He can protect us from harm, only He can guide us through the storms of life, only He can bring us to a safe haven ..."

Abide in Me

"Abide in Me as I abide in you." To abide in Christ is to draw nourishment from Him and His word. To abide in Christ means staying close to Him, as close as a branch that grows from a vine. They are completely connected. To abide in Christ means structuring our lives around loving and serving Him. We abide in Christ through the life-sustaining vine of the Church and the Sacraments. This includes daily prayer, Scripture reading, receiving the Sacraments, keeping God's Commandments, and worshipping Him in the Mass and in the adoration chapel. Jesus specifically told His disciples that receiving Him in the Eucharist is a crucial way to remain in Him: "Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood remains in Me and I in Him" (John 6:56).

Mary Our Model

Mary is presented to us as the first and perfect disciple of Christ and one who remained with Him until the very end. She depended entirely on God and was open to doing His Will. Her entire life was that of humble submission to the Divine Will. With her 'Yes' she united her will with God. The month of May is known as the month of Mary. During this month may we strive to imitate Mary's way of life, her fidelity and obedience. May we also intensify our devotion to the Blessed Mother, especially by praying the rosary daily.




