CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD (CGS)



The **CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD** (**CGS**) program has wrapped up for the year! CGS is a time-tested approach to faith formation that feeds the deepest needs of

children, allowing each one to get to know God personally. In a retreat-like atmosphere and through the use of special materials designed just for them, children hear the Word proclaimed and grow in their relationship with God. This year, the Atrium at St. Joseph's House, right beside Holy Spirit Parish, welcomed 8 children. *Some will be back and space will open for new children to join as well!*
